





2022-2023 Academic Year Erasmus+ Program Student Applications

Applications for the 2022-2023 academic year within the scope of the Erasmus+ Exchange Program will be accepted between January 25 and March 12, 2022. Applications will be taken online.

How are Applications Made?

The <u>application form</u> and your <u>transcript</u> are made online by sending an e-mail to the e-mail address of the Erasmus Institutional Coordinator Gülşah KESENTAŞ. With the "received" e-mail sent in response to your application, it is confirmed that your application forms have been received.

From the Erasmus Exchange Program;

- All students can benefit from at least one and at most two semesters in an academic year.
- Students enrolled in open, external, non-formal or distance education are not eligible.

What are the Application Criteria for Study and Internship Mobility?

• Student's being an associate, undergraduate, graduate or doctoral student enrolled in formal-education higher education programs of Istanbul Gedik University,

- Having a GPA of at least 2.20 out of 4 for associate and undergraduate students,
- The general academic grade point average of graduate and doctorate students must be at least 2.50 out of 4.

• The fact that the student has a course from below does not prevent him/her from benefiting from the program. Students has transferred from another higher education institution with horizontal and vertical transfer and has not yet graduated from the grade point average in the last transcript they received from the higher education institution of the students who did not have a grade point average at T.R. Istanbul Gedik University is taken into account.

Erasmus Application Criteria

* In the selection of Erasmus Study and Internship Students, students are evaluated according to two criteria:

- 1. 50 percent of GANO's point equivalent in the hundredth system
- 2. 50% of the score (out of 100) in the Erasmus English Language Proficiency Exam

The points obtained separately from these criteria are collected and the students are ranked according to the Erasmus Score, taking into account the quotas.

The procedure to increase or decrease the Erasmus Score mentioned above is applied in the following situations or conditions.

Granting:

The student who applies for this posting is deemed to have applied for the project with the Grant Agreement Number 2020-1-TR01-KA103-083096. For this reason, the selected student is entitled within the scope of the project in question and is responsible for its obligations and rules.

Students whose project number is 2020-1-TR01-KA103-083096, which is the required field in the application form, is deemed to have applied for this project.

Grants are given to our students to help them with their additional expenses arising from being abroad during their activity period abroad. Grants are only contributions, not to cover all of our students' expenses related to the activity.

Countries where student mobility activities can be carried out are divided into 3 groups according to their standard of living and monthly education and internship grants are determined for country groups. Country groups and monthly grant amounts to be given to students going to these countries are given in the table below.

Our students receive 80% of the first installment of the grant payment, after they have won the Erasmus program and completed all the processes at the departure stage with the Erasmus Institutional Coordinatorship, and the second installment of 20%, after they return their documents within one week at the latest, after they return this part is paid.
